INSTRUCTIONS FOR VOTING

- 1. You will insert the blank ballot card to activate the machine.
- 2. In a Primary Election, your party is identified when you check-in. Unaffiliated voters can declare their party when they check-in.
- 3. Touch the box containing the candidate of your choice; the box will turn **GREEN** signifying your selection.
- 4. To change your selection, touch the box again and the box will turn white, and you may make a new selection.
- 5. To write-in a candidate, select the Write-In box, across from the office you wish to write-in. A keyboard will appear. Type in the first and last name of the person you wish to write-in.

Touch "ACCEPT". Your write-in choice will appear on the ballot.

- 6. When you have completed your selections, touch the "Print Ballot Button" to view your selections on the window panel to the right, to ensure it represents your selections accurately.
- 7. To Make changes before printing your paper ballot touch "RETURN TO BALLOT".
- 8. To record your vote touch the "CAST VOTE" button only if what is displayed accurately reflects your choices.
- 9. To change your selections after printing, touch "QUIT", and the poll worker will be signaled to assist you.

This is a Primary Election. Therefore you are confined legally to a choice of candidates for nomination within your own political party. The machine is so adjusted as to comply with the law, and will not permit you to vote in the primaries of more than one party

You may vote in person, via a paper Mail-in ballot, at the Hunterdon County Clerk's Office located at 71 Main Street, Flemington, Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. until the deadline of 3:00 p.m. on the Monday before the Primary Election, June 7, 2022. Special hours on Thursday, June 2nd until 7:00 p.m. and Saturday, June 4th from 8:00 a.m. until noon.

You may authorize a messenger to appear at the County Clerk's Office with your completed Application for Vote by Mail Ballot.
