



AQUA NEW JERSEY LEAD SERVICE LINE REPLACEMENT PROGRAM

In July 2021, P.L.2021, Ch.183 (Law) was enacted, requiring all community water systems to identify and replace lead service lines in their service area within 10 years.

Per C.58:12A-41, section 2, the definition of a lead service line now includes galvanized service lines.

A service line is a portion of pipe that connects the water main to the building inlet (as seen in the photo below). Ownership of the service line varies by water system, but for Califon Borough, the service line is owned partially by the water system and partially by the property owner.

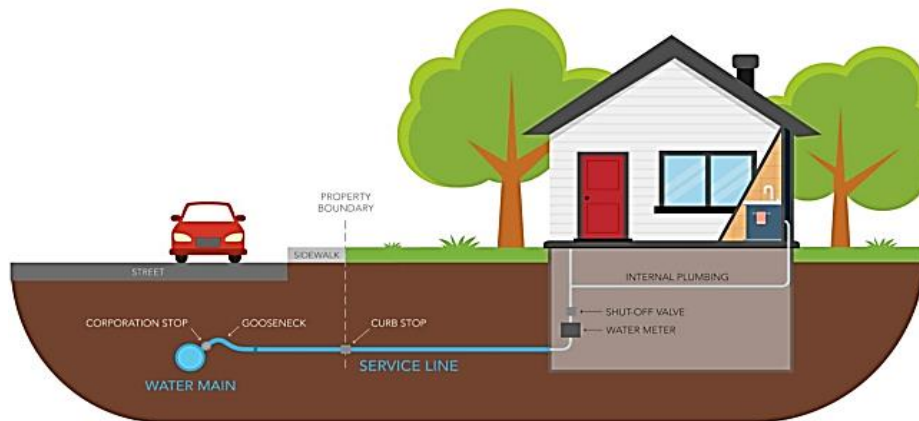

In accordance with the State Law, Aqua has developed a program to replace all lead service lines (including the homeowner-owned portions at no cost) within the next ten years. The first step in this program is to conduct test pit excavations to determine the pipe material of your water service line to your property. The test pit excavations are being completed by Alpha Utility Contractors.
