CarFit

If you are still driving, a CarFit session may help you to "fit more comfortably" behind the wheel and feel safer in your vehicle.

CarFit is a community based educational program that promotes continued safe driving and mobility among older drivers by focusing attention on safety, comfort and fit.

A trained CarFit technician will go through a 12 point checklist including:

- Seatbelt use
- Steering wheel position
- Headrest position
- Blindspot reduction

CarFit is an education program; NOT a driving evaluation. All information is confidential.









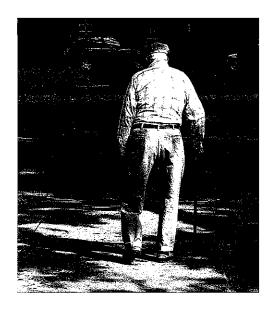


Walking

Senior Pedestrian Safety

This "one on one" or small group program fits the needs of seniors who want to continue to walk safely-whether it is to the mailbox, around their neighborhood, in a parking lot, or to access transit services. A trained staff member will provide guidance on staying safe as a pedestrian.

Each session will include information on best practices for walking with mobility devices (walkers, canes), wearing proper footwear and clothing, staying alert for motorists, use of sidewalks, crosswalks, and crossing at corners. As appropriate, staff will accompany the senior on a walk to demonstrate safe behaviors.
