Accomplishments to Date

In October 2021 we hosted the Vietnam Traveling Memorial Wall. The wall is 3/5 scale of the one in Washington, DC and stands 6' tall, 288' long with 58,276 names on it. The opening ceremony was on October 15, 2021 with over 500 attendees (200+ were grammar school children from Califon Public, Lebanon Township and Tewksbury Township). The wall opened for viewing from October 15th to October 17, 2021 and had just over 3,000 visitors.

Our next accomplishment was having 7 flag poles installed at the Califon Island Park for each branch of military service. Mike Medea of Medea Landscape Studio designed the new walkway and plantings. Christian Pill of Homestead Landscaping installed the new plantings at walkways, the Borough of Califon donated the plantings. It could not have turned out any nicer.

This year we are hosting our 9th Annual Califon Classic Car Show, the 5th year of our All Mopar Car Show and our 5th year of our Wednesday Cruise Night, between the attendees and sponsors all of this would not have happened.
