Califon Island Park

There are few things that are synonymous with summers as a kid growing up. Getting ice cream from the ice cream truck, catching lightning bugs and spending countless hours playing at your local park. We are lucky enough that kids growing up in Califon have access to beautiful Califon Island Park where they can enjoy their summer days.

For newer residents to Califon, myself included, Califon Island Park has always been there but for life-time residents of Califon, they can not only remember a time when it was just e m p t y l a n d b u t t h e transformation it took to the park we all know and love today.



Preparing the land for the park appeared to be no easy task and several residents, including Richard Hoernlen, a former Park Supervisor, even helped clear the land for the park. Through all their hard-work, the park officially opened to the public in the mid 1960's. Shortly after that in July of 1968, the Borough had the old wooden bridge converted to steel to make it safer for people accessing the park.

In 1980, the Little League Field was dedicated to resident, Kenneth Beam. Ken played an integral role in starting the towns Little League program, which at first only had four team: Mets, Yankees, Dodgers & Tigers.

In 2020, the road leading into the park was named "CPL. Edward Morrow Lane" after resident Edward "Eddie" Morrow who lost his life defending our freedoms in the Vietnam War. His brother Bruce, with help from Friends of Califon Park, installed a new Veterans Memorial by the Pavillon this past spring. This beautiful memorial now serves as the backdrop for the annual Memorial Day Ceremony.

Next time you take a stroll through the park, watch kids play on the playground or fish by the river, think of all the memories that were made there and the many more that will be made for generations to come. We should all be grateful to have an amazing park in our town.
