Recognize changing demographics and stressors that are preventing residents from positive community engagement and from aging in place.



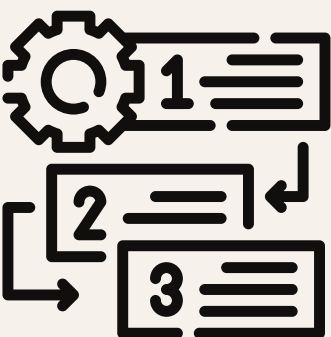
Highlight Trends
